

## Warning Labels

The proper use, application and handling of OPACI-COAT-300® is necessary to its performance as specified and expected. Each lite or IGU must bear a warning label (applied to the glass surface) such as the following:



These labels, supplied in rolls of 3,000, are available for purchase from ICD at cost. Consistent use of the warning labels is very important!

There are recorded cases of contractors installing OPACI-COAT-300® coated products with incompatible materials or in configurations not suitable for OPACI-COAT-300®. Use of these labels helps ensure your customer is immediately informed of necessary precautions and is directed to the source of further information to ensure success of the project.

Please recommend that your customers always contact ICD for current information on approved glazing materials and configurations.

As a final note, these labels (dated 04/20, or later, in the lower left corner) can be easily removed from the glass in one motion without tearing or leaving adhesive residue.
